

Keynote Placement Test

Instructions

The Keynote Placement Test is divided into five sections, each covering a separate skill. Within each section, questions appear in ascending level of difficulty, with the early questions covering the content of Book 1 of Keynote, and the last questions covering the content of Book 5. Note that for the Listening section, the teacher will need to play the seven audio tracks that accompany the test.

The key below can be used to determine which level of Keynote would be most suitable for a learner. For example, if a learner is able to answer all the level 1 questions correctly, but unable to answer all the level 2 questions correctly, Book 2 is likely to be the most suitable level for that student. A learner who is able to answer all Level 6 questions correctly would most likely benefit from using Book 6 of Keynote. In cases where a student performs better in one particular section than another, the average of scores across all sections will need to be considered.
